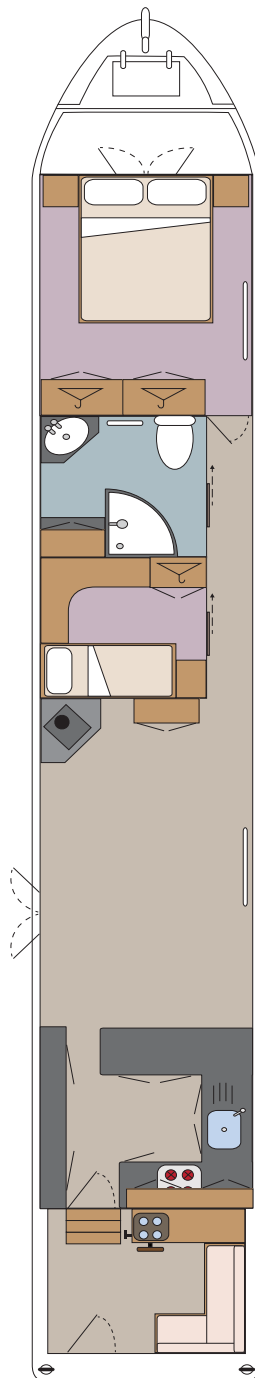

Layout

- Choice of several standard layouts plus bespoke design

EXTERIOR

Steelwork

- Squared stern, with optional wheelhouse
- 12mm baseplate, 8mm hull sides, 5mm cabin sides and 4mm cabin roof
- Stainless steel water tank (1,000 litres)
- 3 x 50mm rubbing strakes including one full length
- Self draining front and rear decks
- High bow section
- Quick release weed hatch
- Steel front escape doors
- Steel side doors
- Fender eyes front, rear & side
- Centre rope ring
- Steel plank & pole rack
- 4 anodes

Engine

- 60hp Canaline diesel with PRM hydraulic gearbox (other engines available at additional cost)

Cruising equipment

- Boarding plank
- Boat pole
- Boat hook
- Front & rear fenders
- Front & rear ropes

Exterior finish

- Two colour (choice) finish with contrast coach line and grip finish to roof, front/rear decks & front/rear gunwale
- Seven coats of paint in total
- Combination of gold anodised 36" x 21" windows & 15" diameter portholes
- Hull blacking in two-pack epoxy primer with Comastic blacking over

Heating

- Diesel central heating with programmer, 3 radiators & heated towel rail
- Twin coil hot water calorifier
- Multi fuel stove

Saloon

- Open plan design and dining area
- Multi fuel stove
- TV unit with aerial/satellite point
- Central heating radiator

Galley

- Stainless steel sink & drainer with chrome monobloc tap
- Built in full size gas oven and grill
- 4 burner hob



- Provision for full size 12 or 230v fridge & freezer
- Wood work surfaces and tiled splash backs (stone also available)
- Custom made fitted base and overhead storage units
- Dishwasher housing (can be substituted for an additional base cupboard if required)

Wheelhouse (optional)

- Fully collapsible double glazed wheelhouse, made from mahogany with insulated roof panels



Interior finish

- Dense spray foam insulation (average 38mm)
- Oak veneered ply to cabin sides and deck head (painted option available)
- Solid oak trims & edging
- Solid plank painted ceiling
- Solid oak door frames throughout including cupboards
- Solid oak window surrounds
- Carpet (choice) to saloon & bedroom
- Vinyl floor covering (choice) to galley and bathroom
- Easy clean laminate shower panel (choice)
- Brass finish to switches, sockets, down lights & mushroom vents
- Substantial bolts to exterior doors & hatches
- Please note, unlike other builders, we **never** use MDF on hull or cabin linings

- 230v ring main circuit with 5 x 2-gang sockets & RCD protection
